Farmland Assessments, Notice to taxpayers:

On Wednesday, May 29, 2019 the Mercer County Farmland Assessment Review Committee held a public meeting on the equalized assessed values proposed by the Illinois Department of Revenue and the implementation of procedures proposed by the Mercer County Supervisor of Assessments. With no opposition, the farmland equalized assessed values and valuation procedures were accepted.

For Assessment Year 2020, the 10% change for the median cropped soil was \$32.01 per acre.

Public Act 98-0109 limits the annual per acre change in certified EAV for each Productivity Index (PI) to 10% of the prior assessment year's value of the median cropped soil (PI 111). The Farmland Assessment Technical Advisory Board has adjusted the certified value for PI 111 by 10%.

This serves as the farmland assessment change notification.
