

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

### **EARLY, GRACE PERIOD AND ABSENTEE VOTING**

Pursuant to Article 19A of the Illinois Election Code, Early Voting for the General Primary Election for all Mercer County Precincts will be conducted at the temporary voting site at the Office of the Mercer County Clerk at the courthouse at 100 SE 3<sup>rd</sup> Street in Aledo beginning February 6, 2020 on weekdays from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. through March 16, 2020. In Person Absentee Voting continues from February 6 until March 16, 2020. Grace Period Voting will be from February 6, 2020 through March 17, 2020 at which time a voter may register and vote at the same time. In addition, the office will be open for In Person Absentee Voting, Grace Period and Early Voting on Saturday, March 14 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. Any voter validly registered in Mercer County may vote during the Early Voting period after showing proper identification, however, any vote cast is final, and may not be revoked, and the voter is not eligible to cast a vote on Election Day.
